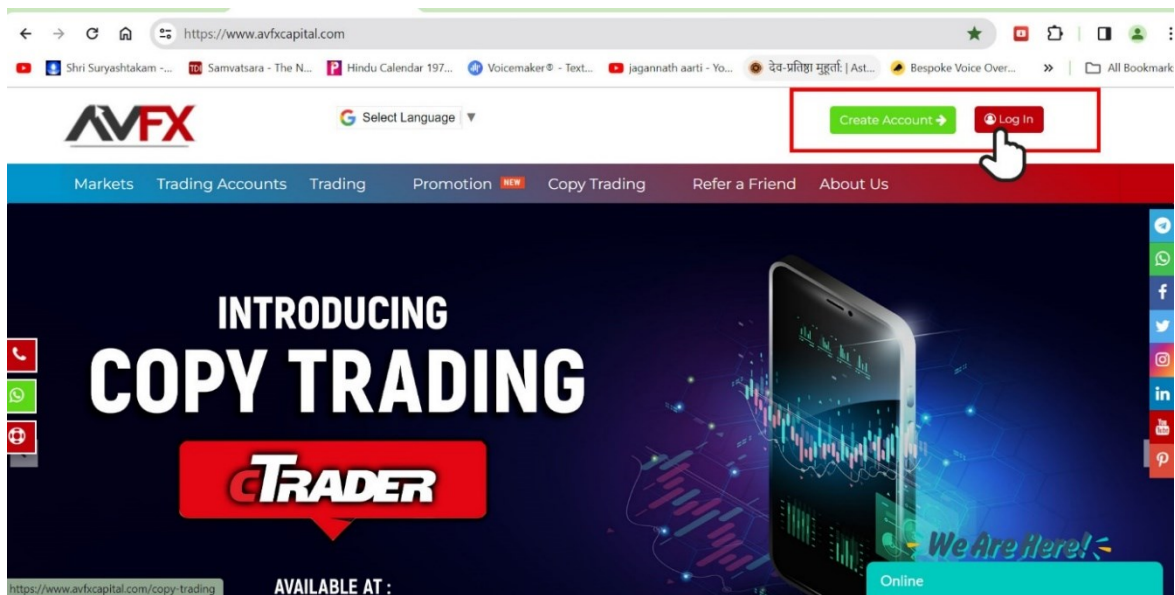


# FOREX TRADING ACCOUNT CLOSURE (AVFX Capital)

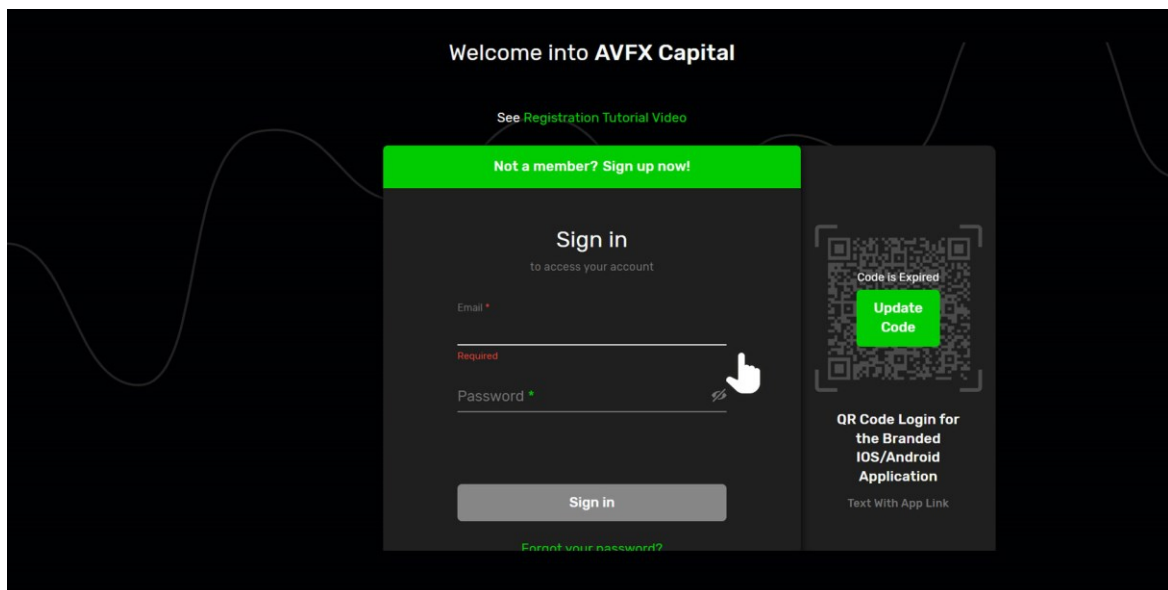

This document will guide you, how to close a Forex Trading Account in more detail. Please look at the following steps:

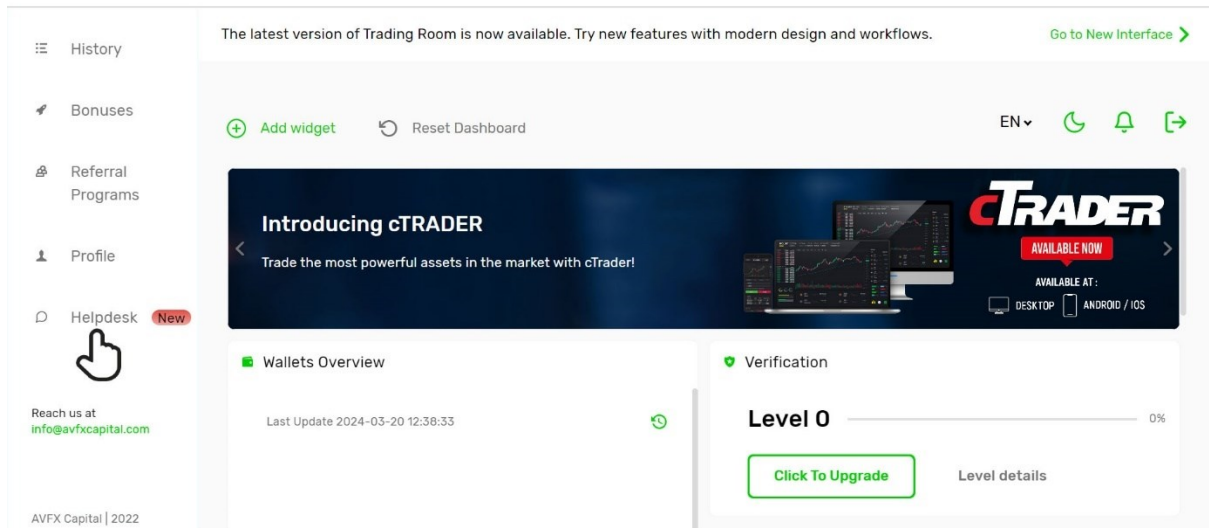
**Step 1:** Open AVFX Capital website(www.avfxcapital.com) website and Log In to your account.



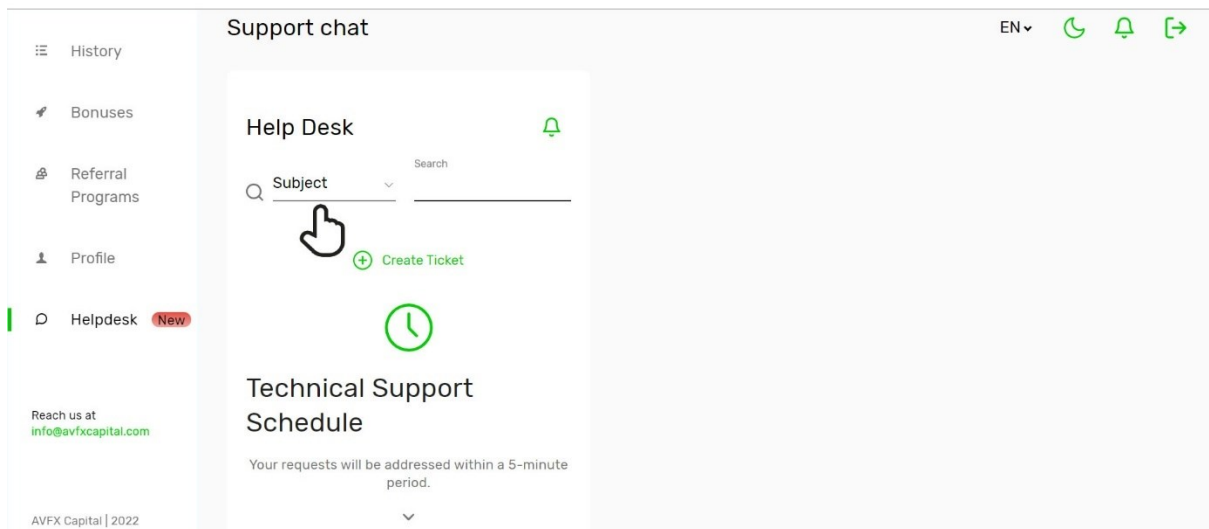
**Step 2:** Log In to your trading account.
